Habakkuk 1:1-4; 2:1-4

Isaiah 59:1-8

See, the LORD's hand is not too short to save, nor [the LORD'S] ear too dull to hear. For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue mutters wickedness....
